ACCOMMODATION October is a busy month in Berkeley and hotel prices are more expensive during this time of year. A few affordable options are listed below:

Knights Inn: Berkeley 512 University Ave, Berkeley, CA 94703, phone: (510) 845-7090. At Knights Inn it may be possible to book a dorm-style room with three beds in each room. This will be very affordable if you are willing to share a room with two of your classmates.

La Quinta Inn: 920 University Ave, Berkeley, CA 94710, Phone (510) 849-1121. <u>Please note</u> <u>that this hotel may be under construction so please contact them ahead of time to be sure they</u> <u>will be available.</u> Be sure to mention to the reservation clerk that you are a PLTS seminary student. We are in conversation with them about giving PLTS students a discounted rate.

For thrifty options, you can check out the **YMCA** next door to campus or <u>Hotel Nash</u>, a couple blocks away, where you can find rooms for under \$100 per night. <u>Airbnb</u> is another option for finding a good deal on accommodations. The PLTS campus is a block from the Downtown Berkeley Bay Area Rapid Transportation (BART) Station.

TRANSPORTATION How to get to PLTS: BART is a convenient ground transportation to reach Berkeley from Oakland or SFO airports. If you have light carry-on baggage, you can use BART, which has stations in Downtown Berkeley and North Berkeley. From the BART station, you can take a taxi for \$15 or \$20, including tips, to accommodations in Berkeley.
