PLTS FALL 2020 COURSE MODALITIES

Due to COVID-19 conditions, all Fall courses will be taught online either synchronously through ZOOM or asynchronously.

"ZOOM/synchronous" means that all students and the professor meet <u>on the screen at the</u> <u>same time</u> over ZOOM every week. (ZOOM/synchronous courses meet on ZOOM at the day/time that appear in the GTU Course Schedule.)

"Asynchronous" means that students do the week's classwork <u>at their own time</u> and interact with other students and the professor on the Moodle platform at different times according to the individual schedule of each student.

All GTU schools have agreed to have their Fall courses and their modalities posted by July 1st (CDSP may need a bit more time).
