

Internship Petition for Geographic Restriction

Geographical Restrictions:

With the concurrence of their candidacy committee, some students may petition the faculty of PLTS to limit their mobility with respect to internship placement.

A request for geographic restriction means that you have chosen geographic location as the highest priority for the internship placement: the specific features of sites and supervisors thus become secondary considerations given the limitations of geography and the availability of sites.

One consequence of identifying geographic location as the highest priority for internship placement is that the usual financial resources assumed in an unrestricted internship will not be available. Specifically, a geographically restricted intern acknowledges that no commitment is being made to provide housing or housing allowance by the internship site.
